

In the series, the animals band together to save the nighttime world from the mysteries that lurk in the dark. Perfect for fans of Kate DeCamillo's *Tale of Despereaux*, Katherine Applegate's *The One and Only Ivan* and Erin Hunter's *Warriors* series, these books will delight readers with their humor, adventure, and exploration of unusual animals.

In *The Nocturnals: The Ominous Eye (HC, \$15.99, September 20, 2016),* when a jolt fractures the earth, the Nocturnal Brigade sets out to investigate its source. Dawn, Bismark, and Tobin meet an unfamiliar reptile—a tuatara named Polyphema—who reveals that a giant beast caused the destruction and will soon strike again. Polyphema with her special insights, claims she is the only one who can help them stop this

fearsome predator... Dawn doesn't trust her and Bismark is in love. With help from a hysterical owl named Otto who has no sense of direction, the jerboas, some falcons, hawks and kiwis, the brigade sets a trap since surrender is not an option!

Tracey Hecht, author and creative visionary behind Fabled Films Press, believes strongly in reading aloud to children, something she does on a regular basis with her family. With the publication of *The Mysterious Abductions*, she partnered with The New York Public Library (NYPL) to launch a Read Aloud Writing Program in a dozen New York City Public Schools. She plans to expand this program across the country with an ALA /AASL Webinar and a national tour for book two-*The Ominous Eye* to libraries, schools and bookstores in Boston, Chicago, Washington DC, Los Angeles, New York, San Francisco, and Seattle.

The Nocturnals will be marketed with a \$500,000 consumer advertising campaign which will include online and social media advertising, animated shorts, a national tour, as well as new content on the website (www.nocturnalsworld.com) for educators, booksellers, parents and children. Consortium Book Sales & Distribution, a member of the Ingram Distribution Companies, will continue to handle sales and distribution.

The series will publish book three in May 2017 with The Nocturnals: The Fallen Star
