

Using fun facts and a narrative from *The Nocturnals* characters—Dawn the fox, Tobin the pangolin, and Bismark the sugar glider—this companion book introduces the reader to the nighttime animals and their natural habitats that inspired Tracey Hecht's Grow & Read early reader book series. Inside the reader will discover the awesome athletic abilities, sensational senses, and powerful protections that allow nocturnal animals to survive! The animals featured in the book include sugar gliders, kinkajous, foxes, bats, snakes, possums, wombats, chinchillas, and pangolins.

To strengthen independent learning, the book's visuals incorporate over 60 exciting full-color photographs of animals and a dozen character illustrations. The book also has an animal glossary, a science word glossary, and at-home resources to build confidence in STEM-based learning.

The world of *The Nocturnals* goes beyond the books: NocturnalsWorld.com features fun printable activities for parents and their children, as well as Common Core Language Arts and Next Generation Science guides for teachers and librarians to support the book program. The activities to use for storytime include SEL activities, crafts, sight word games, and coloring pages.
